


Hiding and Showing Tests

You can show only certain tests to students if you want. For example, if you teach a Pre-Algebra course and you do not want your students to be able to see Elementary Algebra, Geometry, Intermediate Algebra, College Algebra, Trig, etc. You can simply hide them so your students will just see Pre-Algebra.

Login to your College Math Prep Course

In the upper right corner of your screen you will see a “Turn Editing On” button. **Click on that now.**
