

Rubric: CJS 230 Required Team Project

There will be a Team Project which will involve research and classroom presentation by you and your Team members. It will involve work over and above the time spent in the classroom, and will focus on 4 separate assignments involving real world situations. These assignments are listed on the next page. The Team score will be the score given to each member of the Team. This Project will be worth 100 points. The purpose of this exercise is to help you investigate the concepts of Community Oriented Policing in more detail than the text or lectures provide. I strongly urge you to begin work on these as soon as possible. If you have any questions about this project, please ask!

Assignment 1

Develop a Mission Statement for the Sauk Valley Police Department. You will, as a Team, decide the size and makeup of your “Community” and use these criteria in drafting your Mission Statement.

Assignment 2

As a Team, using the same criteria you developed for Assignment 1, decide upon a problem in your community (graffiti, loud parties, littering, etc.) and then use the SARA model to solve it.

Assignment 3

As a Team, using the same criteria you developed for Assignment 1, decide upon the entry-level requirements for a Sauk Valley Police Department patrol officer.

Assignment 4

Using the Internet, identify a police department anywhere in the world except in the United States. Make contact with personnel from that Department and highlight one or two things about that Department’s Community Oriented Policing program. At a minimum, provide the name or names of the persons providing the information and the demographics (location, population and number of police officers) for the whole country and for the individual “community” served by the Department you contact.
