

MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING

SAUK VALLEY COLLEGE BOARD

November 9, 1965

An adjourned meeting of the Sauk Valley College Board was called to order by President Tabor on November 9, 1965, 7:30 P.M., in the Dillon cabin, Sterling.

The roll was called and the following were present: Peter W. Dillon, Catherine R. Perkins, Kenneth L. Reuter, Clayton R. Schuneman, Gerald S. Stuff, Warren E. Walder and Forrest L. Tabor. None was absent.

Also present were representatives of the architectural firms and educational consultants.

The so-called "squatters" of the architects and consultants discussed with the Board the establishing of space relationships, analysis of the site, review of philosophies and the influence on design of topography, budget, circulation, climate utilities and program.

Graphic displays explained the relation of planned areas to available space in the first and subsequent phases.
