Foundation Liaison Yemm reported that the next Foundation meeting would be at 7:30 a.m. Tuesday, April 27, 1999.



1. Each member of the administrative staff shall have a job description which is reviewed, and if necessary, updated each year.
2. Each administrator shall be evaluated each year by his immediate supervisor and/or the President. Such evaluation shall include, but shall not be limited to, job performance as related to the job description, and the accomplishment of mutually agreed upon performance objectives, and the overall objectives of the College.
3. Annual salary recommendations for each administrator shall be made by the President to the Board and shall be based upon the annual evaluation.

For many years I worked at jobs that let me survive in this world, although that's all they did for me. I never went to college right after high school. I was dysfunctional at the time; I was drifting. Needless to say, college was an abstract concept. I wasn't prepared for it; I missed my chance. Twenty-two years later, I had a second chance, a chance that I had yearned for over the years.

I remember the day I was "sparked." I was reading the paper when I saw an article about Sauk Valley Community College's career programs. The article said there were still openings in their Clinical Laboratory Science program. Something just clicked inside me. I can do that, I thought. The thought was just a tiny seed; however, it would grow, as I did.

I wasn't working at a job the day I read that article. I had always worked full time my entire adult life, most recently at my husband's business. It didn't work out too well for me there, so when we were able to swing it, I hired someone for my position and "retired." I had stress burnout and my self-esteem was at an all time low. I was searching for something the day I read that article, although I wasn't aware of this on a conscious level. My life up to this point had been geared towards pleasing everyone else. My own needs and desires had been left behind. I read that article and suddenly realized I wanted, *needed*, to go to college.

I'm not saying this was an easy thing for me. I was scared to death. Would I make it? Was I too old? Too stupid? These negative questions kept playing through my mind like a broken record. I couldn't shake them.

In those first classes I worked endlessly, always thinking everyone else was doing better than I was. To my surprise, this wasn't the case at all. I received straight A's in all of my classes. With each class I took, my confidence level rose. I'm actually making this happen, I would think to myself. Soon, other students were asking me for help. Words can't express the happiness and satisfaction this brought me. My life was

changing, and it was changing for the better. I felt like I did when I was in high school. Back then I was regarded by my peers as a very intelligent, capable person. I was going places. I had forgotten how important this was to me. I craved respect. When I received faculty recommendation to become a tutor, my heart sang.

Attending college has changed me: I'm sociable, I'm happier, I have a sense of purpose. The confidence I've gained from attending college can't be measured; it's off the charts.

I have a "can do" attitude now. Sure, college isn't easy; however, nothing worthwhile, nothing of substance, comes easily. I'm flying high and I'm not coming down.

Subject: 1997 Draft Cohort Default Rate

The Department of Education has released the draft copy of Sauk Valley Community College's cohort default rate for 1997. This report reflects students who received student loans while attending SVCC and entered repayment during the 1997 fiscal year. According to this draft, SVCC's 1997 cohort default rate is 8.5%, which is slightly lower than the previous year's rate.

As you realize, the cohort default rate is a major component of institutional eligibility for participation in the Title IV programs. Currently, SVCC is well within Title IV institutional eligibility requirements with regards to our cohort default rate. Additionally, no significant changes are expected between this draft and the official cohort default rate that should be released later this summer.

Dear Mr. Seguin:

Once again, Illinois' adult education programs contributed significantly to helping TANF clients in their effort to become self-sufficient. During FY98, the programs served 12,446 students who were receiving Temporary Assistance to Needy Families. Of these, 39.4% increased their earnings enough to have their monthly cash assistance reduced or their case cancelled altogether. This rate of accomplishment is nearly twice as high as the preceding year, when 20.4% of TANF students served had become employed and/or increased their earnings.

Their personal achievements meant that Illinois avoided an estimated \$14.6 million in annual welfare expenditures. These welfare savings include either (a) the amount of the client's monthly grant when the case was cancelled or (b), in the case of the clients with earnings who receive a partial grant, one-third of their monthly income. Welfare savings amount to \$1.38 for every dollar appropriated for the program. The estimate of savings is based only on reductions in cash assistance; it does not include reductions in Medicaid costs or increases in tax revenues.

Of the public assistance students served at Sauk Valley Community College, 23 students subsequently increased their earnings enough to have their assistance grant reduced or cancelled. The estimated annual savings attributed to Sauk Valley Community College was \$92,112.

Adult educators across the State can be proud that they helped some determined people shape a better future for themselves. You have played a significant role in the lives of these students and the communities you serve.

The Search Committee and administration are recommending the appointment of Dr. Deborah J. Hecht as Vice President of Instructional Services. The College received 23 applications for this position and four candidates were invited to the campus for interviews. It was the unanimous decision of the administration and Search Committee to offer the job to Dr. Deborah Hecht of Lake City, Florida.

RECOMMENDATION: Board approval of the appointment of Dr. Deborah J. Hecht as Vice President of Instructional Services, effective July 1, 1999 at an annual salary of \$85,000.

Instructions: This Recommendation for Appointment form is designed to provide authorization for all new employees and for changes affecting current employees. It can be obtained from the Coordinator of Personnel Services and is to be completed by the department Supervisor/Dean.

1. For new employees complete parts 1, 2 and 3:

Note: Special instructions may include conditions for new employees such as a 90 to 120 day probationary period.

The packet of information accompanying this form should contain at the minimum:

- A) Resume and/or application for employment.
- B) Reference checking documents.
- C) Interview evaluation.
- D) Memo indicating that the data compiled by AA/EEO was examined prior to final selection.
- E) Salary justification memo if the proposed salary is higher than the minimum band for that scale.
- F) Copy of the current job description.
- G) Demographics Form.

Once complete, the packet will be reviewed by the Affirmative Action Officer and the Coordinator of Personnel Services.

Authorizations:

- A) Applicants signature is required after the candidate has accepted the position. This confirms that the applicant understands and agrees to the terms and salary of the position.
- B) The packet is then reviewed and signed by the appropriate Supervisor/Dean and Vice President acknowledging the recommendation.
- C) Final approving authority will be the President's or the Board of Trustees depending on the position to be filled.

Once approved, the original packet will be forwarded to the Coordinator of Personnel Services.

- 2. For changes in biographical information complete parts 1, 2 and 3 as instructed above for new employees except, only packet items E), F) and G) are required.
- 3. For Temporary changes of current employees such as department or account number changes, complete part 1 and Supervisor/Dean's signature of part 3 only. No other information is required to accompany this form.

Analysis of Qualifications

Academic:

Deborah Hecht holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas and a Ph.D. in Human Experimental Psychology from the University of Texas.

Professional Background:

Dr. Hecht has fifteen years of full-time academic administrative experience and approximately fourteen years of varied part-time teaching experience at various schools. More specifically, she has been a chief academic officer since July 1990 (two years at Western Nebraska Community College and her current seven years as Vice President for Instruction at Lake City Community College in Florida).

Personnel Qualifications:

Dr. Hecht displayed excellent communication, personal, and academic leadership skills during her visit to the campus. Her list of accomplishments while a chief academic officer is impressive and it should qualify her well to be a vice president at Sauk.

References:

The committee checked ten references on Dr. Hecht and I checked two myself. These were people who were both on and off her provided list of references. All of them attest to her academic leadership, program development, people, and communication skills. In fact, her references were completely positive and none of our questions were given any negative response by her references.

Announcement Process

The position was advertised in the following manner:

1. Internally, an advertisement of the vacancy was distributed throughout the institution.
2. Announcement of the vacancy was distributed to all community colleges in the state of Illinois.
3. An announcement of the vacancy was placed in *The Chronicle of Higher Education*.

During the search, 23 applications were received. The field was narrowed down to 6 finalists, references were checked on them, and four of those individuals were subsequently interviewed by the Search Committee.

The Search Committee -- (see attached) was unanimous in choosing Dr. Hecht for the position of Vice President of Instructional Services. In addition, the Vice Presidents as well as the entire Instructional Services staff were involved in the interview process and all concurred with the selection of Dr. Hecht to be recommended to the Board of Trustees as the next Vice President of Instructional Services.

Dear Mr. Devan,

Please accept this letter and the accompanying documents as my formal application for the position of Vice President of Instructional Services. I believe that my skills, abilities, and particularly my educational convictions may be congruent with your needs.

The record of accomplishment that supports my application includes an earned doctorate from the University of Texas, undergraduate teaching experience and a progression of increasingly responsible positions leading to my present position as Vice President for Instruction at Lake City Community College. LCCC is a comprehensive community college located in rural north central Florida, with approximately 2200 FTE students. Our program mix includes the traditional A.A. transfer degree as well as A.S. degrees in such diverse fields as Golf Course Management, Computer Science, Electronics and several health related areas.

I am firmly committed to the mission of a two-year institution in serving the needs of the community which created and sustains it. The success of the institution is dependant upon meeting those community needs. By assessing those needs, appropriate programming and services can be provided. These assessments must be done periodically to enable the institution to remain dynamic - changing and improving its programs as those community needs change. Two year institutions must respond to the challenge of meeting students where they are and creating a teaching/learning environment where those students can reach their goals. With a range of programming from developmental through transfer through vocational/technical programs through business/industry partnerships, the institution must support various strategies to maintain the multi-dimensional educational environment. I have developed strategic partnerships to provide training to local business and industry clients and have negotiated an articulation agreement with a private four year institution to provide courses on our campus to allow our place bound students to earn a baccalaureate degree without leaving this community.

Creating and maintaining this multi-dimensional environment requires a communication pattern that depends on listening - to the community, the students, the faculty and the staff. The Vice President must actively seek out these groups and individuals for input. The Vice President must work with the business leaders, service clubs, local chambers of commerce and other educational institutions in the service area to determine if the college is providing adequate and appropriate services. Yet, the Vice President must also maintain the integrity

and mission of the institution in the face of those potentially conflicting community needs. Part of my responsibilities as a member of the administrative team is to listen and respond to community needs, and present the college's perspective on those needs.

All educational enterprises are created to serve the needs of a constituency which may be national, regional, or local in scope. Community colleges have developed programs and activities to serve their diverse community clientele. We have served as cultural centers, the first choice for business and industry training, an education center for those for whom English is not their native language, a source for personal growth/development activities, and outreach arms into the local high schools. As these activities have mushroomed, competition for resources, both financial and personal, has increased. Because the future of the community is so closely bound to the skills and capabilities of its citizens, each college must commit to an institutional development program that will support the growth and development of the community.

My management style can be characterized as consultive. I ask for and receive input from all affected parties to a decision. I am not, however, afraid to make unpopular decisions in the best interests of the college. I am particularly skilled in developing and implementing a supportive culture and thereby an environment that fosters experimentation and progressive pursuits, encourages responsible risk taking and challenges all members of the community to meet goals by exploring and inventing new and stimulating ways to develop solutions to the many challenges facing the institution.

I have been heavily involved in and committed to technical education throughout my career. I am aware of the demographic studies maintaining that most new jobs will be in the technical areas in the years to come. It thus becomes critically important that two-year institutions respond appropriately to the needs of business and industry in our areas and provide both educated and trained workers. This entails constant dialogue and partnerships with local employers, both to assess their needs and to ensure that we are current in teaching methodologies, equipment, and skill development of our students.

A community college which offers both technical and transfer programs offers some problems, but many opportunities. An atmosphere of openness, trust and cooperation needs to be established to vitalize the opportunities. Student's needs change as they move through our institutions. Technical courses to prepare for job entry may inspire the student to continue his/her education at the upper division level. Transfer students may see the need for immediate employment and change to a technical major. Curricular integration and integrating more traditional academic areas into technical courses allow the student to transition from one area to another. Additionally, as technical education becomes more academically based, conversations and cooperation between the areas becomes even more important.

Within the limits of state budgetary constraints, LCCC is working to integrate technology in all facets of the organization. We are currently utilizing a \$250,000 federal grant which has enabled us to partner with university, cable, and broadcast enterprises (who are contributing another \$350,000 in services and equipment) to provide distance learning opportunities to selected sites within our far-flung five county district. Our program is cited a model for rural areas and has been discussed before the Congress of the United States in regard to our REA

proposal. We currently utilize the college's cable TV station to broadcast telecourses and other local programming to our constituency and this is expanding to full two-way interactive communication both by broadcast and through the Internet.

Working with the Dean of Applied Technology, we are training faculty to utilize computers, multimedia technologies, and the Internet to enhance the classroom educational experience. All students have computer access -- directly in class, independently through the Learning Lab, or via various computer labs sited throughout campus. Management has direct access to statewide and institutionally based data to allow timely and informed decision making and we are working on on-line registration and other technology support systems for the student and faculty.

As Instructional Vice President, I control in excess of \$6.5M of the college's total budget of \$11M. Resource allocation is accomplished with the division chairs and deans in an open meeting where the fiscal consequences of academic decisions are debated and consensus is reached. I have instituted a weekly meeting of the management team to review funding requests from each of the divisions. This meeting has allowed each of us to develop a more holistic picture of the institution and ensure that institutional priorities are sustained.

Budgeting is now the province of all interested parties. As the academic leader of a small institution, I have also been involved in the implementation of the new financial aid regulations. I have worked with the LCCC Foundation on fundraisers and have utilized the Academic Improvement Trust Fund to fund capital equipment for the college. We have been successful in augmenting state funds with both governmental and foundation grants and contracts. "Cost plus" custom programming for business and industry is emerging as a new source of resources.

Throughout my career I have been involved in establishing novel methods for supporting programs. I supervise the economic development initiatives of the college. These include ongoing programs to train sheet metal workers for an adjacent, major aircraft refurbishing company and a JTPA program to train and support displaced and underemployed citizens. We work closely with the five district Chambers of Commerce to provide educational opportunities for the workers of companies considering our area for new business opportunity. Our "Take Control" program provides support for the displaced homemaker and the "Center for Excellence" works with low income minority high school students to demonstrate that college is a viable option. As an integral part of the economic viability of this rural region, it is incumbent upon the college to provide these and other services to enhance the lives and economic well-being of our constituency.

In all of my previous positions, I have been involved in community education, building partnerships with business and industry and outreach efforts in the college's district. While at the Community College of Southern Nevada, I was responsible for all off campus courses, both credit and non-credit, in a district that stretched as far as 250 miles north of the main campus. Additionally, I had responsibility for the programs at Nellis Air Force Base and the two local prisons. At Western Nebraska, the Director of Continuing Education and the Director of Business/Industry training reported to my office. We were able to take a consistently money losing program and, within a space of three years, provide a surplus of well over \$30,000.

Outcomes assessment is an integral part of all LCCC programs. Florida is currently moving toward Performance Based Funding (and moving away from an FTE model), thus measurable outcomes are critical in both ongoing and potential new programs. Our strategic plan includes "closed loop" assessments whereby programs are benchmarked against previously determined criteria, and revised and improved based upon those benchmarks. For example, we have recently reviewed and improved our developmental math sequence to ensure better learning, retention and pass rates for our students. Working with personnel in student development, we have also mandated a student success course as a co-requisite for any student who tests into any developmental course. Mandatory testing and placement has improved our students' ability to succeed in subsequent college level courses.

Faculty and staff at Lake City Community College are working together with management as a team to develop a community college with a future, a vision, and an educational paradigm predicated on excellence in what we do. As a key player on that team, strategic planning is one of the responsibilities that I have chosen to adopt since it is the base from which the needed vision can arise. The responsibility for communicating with college stakeholders and developing environmental information upon which to base a sound strategic planning policy was sadly lacking and I have chosen to bring this within my purview. Student and staff surveys, community focus groups, and workshops with the Board of Trustees are the basis on which to develop broad policy objectives. Using these forums, we are rethinking the way in which we deliver higher education and how we must respond to both internal and external change. Over the past three years, we have reestablished the planning system including an update of the college philosophy, the mission, long term goals, Divisional missions and objectives, and a full set of policies and procedures to support these processes. Most importantly, this system includes a reporting and accountability system that provides for a feedback linkage to planning which will continually finetune the plan and bring the college to higher levels of performance excellence. This has been a most interesting process with stakeholders at different levels of acceptance and understanding; however with continuing critique and dialogue, the plans will become more highly tuned and the college more prepared for the future in pursuit of a common vision.
