November 25, 2002

The Board of Trustees of Sauk Valley Community College met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. on November 25, 2002 in the third floor Board Room of Sauk Valley Community College, 173 Illinois Route #2, Dixon, Illinois..

Call to Order: Chair Wolf called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and the following members answered roll call:

Secretary Pro-Tem: It was moved by Member Simpson and seconded by Member Thompson that the Board appoint Member Dixon Secretary Pro-tem. In a roll call vote, the following was recorded: Ayes - Members Andersen, Simpson, Thompson, von Bergen Wessels and Wolf. Nays - Member Dixon. Motion carried. Student Trustee Singleton advisory vote: aye.

Consent Agenda: It was moved by Member Andersen and seconded by Member Thompson that items D-2 and D-3 be removed from the Consent Agenda and the balance of the items be approved as presented. In a roll call vote, all voted aye. Motion carried. Student Trustee Singleton advisory vote: aye.

Treasurer's Report: It was moved by Member Andersen and seconded by Member Simpson that the Board approve Agenda Item D-2 Treasurer's Report. Discussion followed. In a roll call vote, all voted aye. Motion carried. Student Trustee Singleton advisory vote: aye.

- Bills Payable: It was moved by Member Dixon and seconded by Student Trustee Singleton that the Board approve Agenda Item D-3 Bills Payable. Discussion followed. In a roll call vote, all voted aye. Student Trustee Singleton advisory vote: aye.
- President's Report: President Behrendt reported on the status of the Skyhawk Polygraph Institute, that registration for the Spring semester was up 8.6% over last year at this time, and that Sauk students who transfer to Northern Illinois University (Summer 2002 semester) continue to maintain higher GPAs than other students.
- Tax Levy Approval: It was moved by Member Simpson and seconded by Member Dixon that the Board approve the 2002 tax levy as presented with the stipulation that the property tax adopted for the calendar year 2002 (to be collected in the calendar year 2003) be allocated 50% for fiscal year 2003 and 50% for fiscal year 2004. Discussion followed. It was moved by Member von Bergen Wessels and seconded by Member Dixon that the motion be amended to include the stipulation that the Educational Fund Levy be reduced by \$660,000 and this money be returned to the tax payers of the district. Discussion followed. It was then moved by Member Andersen and seconded by Member Dixon that the Board table this motion until the December 2002 meeting. In a roll call vote, the following was recorded: Ayes - Members Andersen, Dixon, Thompson, and von Bergen Wessels. Nays - Members Simpson and Wolf. Motion carried. Student Trustee Singleton advisory vote: aye.
- Closed Session: At 7:30 p.m. it was moved by Member Dixon and seconded by Student Trustee Singleton that the Board adjourn to closed session to discuss the appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance or dismissal of specific employees of the College, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee to determine its validity, collective negotiating matters, and closed session minutes consideration. In a roll call vote, all voted aye. Motion carried. Student Trustee Singleton advisory vote: aye.
- Regular Session: The Board returned to regular session at 8:20 p.m.

- Closed Session Minutes: It was moved by Member Dixon and seconded by Student Trustee Singleton that the Board approve the minutes of the October 28th closed session, **as amended**. In a roll call vote, all voted aye. Motion carried. Student Trustee Singleton advisory vote: aye.
- Faculty Appointment: It was moved by Member von Bergen Wessels and seconded by Student Trustee Singleton that the Board approve the appointment of Amanda K. Vos as an Assistant Professor of English/Education, effective January 13, 2003, at a 12-month salary of \$31,600 (to be pro-rated). In a roll call vote, all voted aye. Motion carried. Student Trustee Singleton advisory vote: aye.
- Part-time Faculty Collective Bargaining Committee: It was moved by Member Dixon and seconded by Member Simpson that the Board approve the appointment of Ruth Bittner, Dave Murray, and Tony Miller as the SVCC Bargaining team. In a roll call vote, all voted aye. Motion carried. Student Trustee Singleton advisory vote: aye.
- Administrative Re-organization: It was moved by Member Andersen and seconded by Member Simpson that the Board approve an administrative reclassification to move the Physical Education program and Fitness Center to a new Division of Health and Physical Education to be headed by a Dean of Health and Physical Education (with this position to replace the current Director of Health Careers Education position.) In a roll call vote, the following was recorded: Ayes - Members Andersen, Simpson, Thompson, and von Bergen Wessels. Nays - Members Dixon and Wolf. Motion carried. Student Trustee Singleton advisory vote: aye.
- Retreat Date: The Board discussed a date for the Winter Retreat and decided on January 30, 2003 at 12 noon in the Board Room of the College.
- Reports: Student Trustee Singleton reported on the success of the Global Awareness programs, the visit to the Thomson prison, the ICCTA meeting he attended in Chicago, and the Relaxation Seminar to be held on December 4th.
- Foundation Liaison Andersen reported that the next Foundation meeting will be held on December 10th at 7:30 a.m.

ICCTA Representative Thompson reported on the ICCTA meeting he had attended in Chicago.

Adjournment: Since the scheduled business was completed, it was moved by Member Dixon and seconded by Student Trustee Singleton that the Board adjourn. CHANGE IN BOARD POLICY 419.01 (FRINGE BENEFITS)

SECOND READING

As the attached memo details, we recently considered adding choices for voluntary supplemental benefits for our staff. However, we discovered that while the faculty contract language allows us to add such benefits as pre-tax Section 125 cafeteria plan deductions, current Board Policy 419.01 does not permit this deduction. Therefore, we are recommending that we modify the wording in Board Policy 419.01 to allow for such a deduction so that the language is parallel to that contained in the faculty contract and also allow more options for these deductions.

In response to requests from a number of employees who are interested in adding choices for voluntary supplemental benefits, we recently hosted a visit from AFLAC. AFLAC has offered our employees benefits in the form of insurance policies that cover accident expenses, sickness indemnity, short-term disability, cancer, and dental care. Premiums are paid 100% by employees through payroll deduction.

Because of the premium cost, a number of employees would like to elect to make the payments as pre-tax, Section 125 cafeteria plan deductions. Such payments are qualified according to the Internal Revenue Code.

To enable this option, we must make a change to Board Policy 419.01 "Fringe Benefits" and amend the official cafeteria plan document. The proposed change in Board policy will make the policy language similar to that contained in the faculty contract. The faculty contract language is broad enough to enable AFLAC as a Section 125 deduction without making additional changes to the contract.

While AFLAC is the current "trigger" for this recommended change, this would make our Board Policy 419.01 and the faculty contract compatible. Both provisions would now say the same thing.

The proposed plan amendment simply states that the new AFLAC offerings are added to the plan.

I recommend Board of Trustees approval of the proposed change in Board policy 419.01, and next month of the amendment to the Section 125 cafeteria plan document.

terminated from the College's group health plan. (On August 18, 1997, the Governor approved Senate Bill 423 which established a program of health, dental and vision benefits for retired employees of community college districts. This plan will be administered by the Illinois Department of Central Management Services and is similar to the benefits provided to state university retirees.)

C. Section 125 - details of Section 125 for all full-time faculty members may be found in the Faculty Contract.

The Board shall establish a Section 125 plan in accordance with the requirements of Section 125 of the Internal Revenue Code through salary reduction that will allow full-time staff **any allowable expenses not paid by the Board** to elect to designate a portion of their salary for the payment of ~~group insurance premiums~~.

D. Tuition Free Enrollment - details of tuition free enrollment for all full-time faculty members may be found in the Faculty Contract.

The college offers tuition free enrollment at Sauk Valley Community College for all full-time employees, their spouses, and their children under 23 years of age. Part-time employees

working at least 20 hours per week and having completed 1 year of service are eligible for tuition waivers on a prorated basis. If an employee dies while working for the College, this tuition waiver will remain in effect for his/her surviving dependents under 23 years of age. It is the obligation of the employee to pay the student activity fee.

E. Academic Robe Expenses - the College will pay regular expenses for academic robes and regalia required for any Sauk Valley Function.

F. Tuition Reimbursement - details of tuition reimbursement for all full-time faculty members may be found in the Faculty Contract.

The Board will pay tuition and mandatory fees at the rate of not more than \$115 per credit hour up to a maximum of \$1,380 per year for those courses taken by full-time administrators, and full-time support and professional/technical staff, providing these courses are related to their work at the College. All courses must be approved in advance by the respective Vice President/ President and reimbursement will be limited to 12 credit hours per year. Any exceptions are to be made by the appropriate Vice President/President with the approval of a

FROM SVCC FACULTY ASSOCIATION CONTRACT

- 15.6 Tuition Reimbursement will be based upon Article 6, Section 6.5.
- A. The Board will reimburse tuition and mandatory course fees at the rate of up to \$115 per credit hour to a maximum of \$1,380 per year.
 - B. Reimbursement for tuition may be used for graduate or undergraduate credit and for workshops, seminars, and symposiums as equated by the appropriate Vice President.
 - C. Tuition reimbursement will be limited to twelve (12) semester credit hours per fiscal year.
 - D. Tuition reimbursement shall be paid to faculty on approved leaves of absence for a maximum period of one (1) year at a rate not to exceed \$100 per credit hour and up to a total of thirty (30) credit hours. Tuition reimbursement does not apply in cases where these costs are covered by grants, scholarships, or assistantships.
 - E. Tuition reimbursement shall be made upon presentation of a voucher or receipt from the institution where the faculty member was enrolled to the Vice President of Administrative Services and should bear the endorsement of the appropriate Vice President approving such reimbursement, and upon completion of the course and receipt of transcript.
- 15.7 The Board shall establish a Section 125 plan through salary reduction that will allow faculty members to elect to designate a portion of their salary for the payment of any allowable expenses not paid by the Board, in accordance with the requirements of Section 125 of the Internal Revenue Code.

404.01 Appointment of College Staff

- A. Administrative staff and instructional faculty shall be appointed by the President subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees.
- B. Support and professional/technical staff shall be interviewed and recommended for appointment by their appropriate supervisors. Salary recommendations shall be reviewed by the Vice President of Administrative Services and all support and professional/technical staff appointments shall be subject to the approval of the President.

405.01 Appointment of Instructional and Administrative Personnel

Normally, instructional and administrative personnel shall initially be appointed for no longer than one year. Such appointments must be reviewed annually.

Eligibility for tenure for instructional faculty is based upon completion of three years of full-time professional service at Sauk Valley Community College. Administrators are not eligible for tenure.

Notice of Non-reappointment

For instructional faculty not on tenure, if the employee is not to be re-employed at the end of the employee's contract, the employee shall be given written notice no later than March 1 of the contract year. Non-reappointment of administrative personnel is as defined in the policy pertaining to contract continuation for administrative personnel.

TAX LEVY APPROVAL

Attached is the proposed tax levy for 2002 (payable 2003).

State law requires us to file a tax levy with the county clerks by the fourth Tuesday of December. Attached is Sauk's proposed Certificate of Tax Levy for 2002. The proposed levy for non-debt funds is less than 105% of the 2001 extension, so no Truth in Taxation hearing is required this year. If approved, the estimated tax rate for 2002 will be 46.16 cents per hundred dollars of equalized assessed valuation (EAV), down from 46.44 cents in 2001. The following table compares the two years' levies and tax rates:

Early information from the district's six county assessors indicates that the 2002 EAV will increase about 2% from 2001, from \$1,227,176,699 to \$1,251,720,232. In 2000 and 2001, EAV increased by 2.9% and 2.6% respectively. However, the actual tax base upon which our tax revenue is collected will not be determined until May 2003. Therefore, the request for tax revenue in the Education and Operations and Maintenance Funds needs to be set slightly higher than the anticipated actual base in order to provide the College with all of the tax revenue previously authorized by the public.

The Protection, Health and Safety levy equals the cost of the capital projects that the Board approved in October. The Bond and Interest levy is the amount needed to meet annual principal and interest payments on our insurance reserve fund and funding bonds.

The Social Security/Medicare and Audit Fund levies are set at estimates of actual costs for those functions next fiscal year. The Liability, Protection and Settlement Fund levy represents estimated expenditures for affirmative action, risk management and public safety functions for next fiscal year, less expected investment earnings from the insurance reserve fund.

The total tax rate for 2001 was \$.4644 per \$100 of EAV. A house valued at \$100,000 has an EAV of \$33,333, so its Sauk tax in 2001 was \$154.80. The Sauk tax for the same house at the estimated proposed 2002 rate of \$.4616 will be \$153.87, a 0.6% decrease. The proposed non-debt rate of \$.3507 is the lowest since 1986.

In addition to the statements made on the accompanying Certificate of Tax Levy, by approving this resolution the Board of Trustees also approves the following statement for GASB accounting purposes:

That the property tax levy adopted by the Board of Trustees for the calendar year 2002 to be collected in the calendar year 2003 be allocated 50% for fiscal year 2003 and 50% for fiscal year 2004.

I recommend Board of Trustee approval of the 2002 tax levy as presented. Thank you.

I would like to recommend that we appoint Ms. Amanda Vos as an Assistant Professor in the areas of English and Education. In support of this recommendation, I offer the following information:

Announcement Process

The multidisciplinary faculty position was advertised in the *Dixon Evening Telegraph*, the *Sterling Gazette*, *The Chronicle of Higher Education*, *The Quad City Times*, *The Rockford Register Star*, newspapers in both DeKalb and Peoria, Sauk's Employment Website and the Chamber of Commerce NationJob.com network.

Application Responses

Forty-three applications were received. Ten applicants met the minimum qualifications.

Screening

A committee composed of Dr. Patrick Kennedy, Mr. Richard Eichman, Ms. Ann Daly, Dr. Randall Norris, Mr. Noel Berkey, Mr. Jason Hedrick and Mr. John Nelson and chaired by Vice President Dr. Deborah Hecht, reviewed the applications of all the candidates who met the minimum qualifications. After checking references, two candidates were invited to interview at the Sauk Valley Community College campus. Both candidates were interviewed by the committee, the Vice President of Instructional Services, individually by the Dean, and the President. Each candidate also provided a writing sample and did a teaching demonstration before the committee.

Qualifications

1. Academic Background – Ms. Vos has been working on her Ed.D. in Curriculum and Supervision at Northern Illinois University. She currently holds an M.A. in Literature and Pedagogy from the same institution and has a B.A. in Literature from the University of Miami.
2. Professional Background – Ms. Vos has served as a part-time English instructor at Sauk Valley Community College since Spring of 2000. Additionally, she has worked as an adjunct English instructor at Rock Valley College and Kishwaukee College. She has taught both Reading and English for Northern Illinois University.

References

Ms. Vos' references were checked by the committee members and the Vice President for Instructional Services. Her references state that Ms. Vos is well organized and well prepared for her classes. Students respond well to her style of teaching and she maintains appropriately high standards and appears interested in helping the students achieve the objectives of her courses.

Our screening committee has indicated that Amanda Vos should fit very well with our faculty and student body. I recommend the employment of Amanda Vos as the English/Education Assistant Professor Step 1 without reservation of any kind.

RE: Administrative Reclassification Request

As you know, any time there is a personnel change in any position at the College, we examine that vacated position to see if we can strengthen the institution by structuring it differently. With the retirement of Rosemary Johnson as Director of Health Careers Education, we reviewed that impending vacancy.

I propose moving the Physical Education Department and the Fitness Center to a new division of Health and Physical Education to be headed by a Dean of Health and Physical Education.

There are a number of reasons for this recommendation:

1. Workload/Scope of Responsibility

First, the attached duties and responsibilities of the Dean of Business, Technology and Natural Sciences (for example) and the Director of Health Careers Education are parallel and very close in the total number of essential functions, so there already is great similarity between the current Director and Dean position. Next, we have recently added the new Paramedic Program that has increased the workload for the Director of Health Careers Education. Likewise, the transfer of adult education last July from K-12 to the community colleges has meant that the Dean of Arts, Social Sciences, ADULT EDUCATION, and Physical Education now has five additional full-time staff, a new site (Wallace School) and approximately \$150,000 more budget to

administer. So moving the Physical Education Department and the Fitness Center from this Dean to the proposed Dean of Health and Physical Education will both reduce the recently added additional responsibilities to the Dean as well as recognize the additional responsibilities of the Director created by the new Paramedic Program and the Physical Education move.

There are several factors that are unique and set the health position apart from the current Dean areas of expertise. This health position requires a greater degree of competency in the nursing profession, radiology, certifications, and administration of the health programs. Furthermore, competency-based proficiency insures that College programs must be in accordance with state and federal guidelines and that all regulatory requirements are met. In addition, there is a greater responsibility for additional sites as well as the adherence to external agency rules. All of these factors add up to offset the apparent inequity in the scope of responsibility.

2. Recruiting Candidates

Currently, the Dean of Business, Technology and Natural Sciences earns \$73,251, the Dean of Arts, Social Science, Adult Education and Physical Education earns \$66,300 and the Director of Health Careers Education earns \$62,059. Since the Director classification range is only \$45,235 to \$67,853, it seems unlikely that we would be able to attract a Masters plus candidate in the Director salary range. More likely, it is expected that we will need to pay in the \$65,000 - \$75,000 range because of the unique requirements of the position (with or without Physical Education) combined with the current shortage of health careers professionals.

The nursing shortage is acute and will continue to increase over the next few years. This shortage is compounded by the fact that hospitals are using high-pressure recruiting tactics and offering bonuses to attract the very best to their organization. This hampers the College's ability to fill and retain critical academic nursing positions.

This position as a Dean rather than a Director would attract a nursing professional with the prerequisite qualifications needed to maintain and sustain a quality nursing program. Recruitment for this position will be extremely difficult, unless the

position is placed in the proper perspective based on competency and high degree of difficulty required for this position.

A positive spin-off as the Dean of Health and Physical Education will be the ability to recruit and attract nursing/radiology faculty to the programs here at Sauk. The title of Dean will be considered by the potential applicants as a sign of a quality program on par with the other programs offered by the College.

3. Teamwork Enhancement

If all instructional heads are at the same administrative level (Dean), teamwork and cooperation will be fostered. Currently, the Instructional Services Council consists of four Deans and a Director; placing all five on the same administrative level will be more egalitarian.

During difficult and possibly austere times in recruiting, the College must be innovative in its approach to future challenges. This change is positive and is a "win-win" for Sauk.
