## Presentation:

As of June 6,2017, enrollment of Sauk's "standard" students (degree and certilicate seekers) had declined by $11.9 \%$ in headcount and $12.1 \%$ in credit hours in the summer semester, 2017 as compared to summer semester, 2016. Additionally, the number of credits that were paid (not waived by the College) decreased by $10.1 \%$ over 2016. Duat-credit summer enrollment is down $8.6 \%$ in headcount but up $16.7 \%$ in credit hours. Dual-credit students make up only a small fraction of the credit hours taken by students in the summer. Federal financial aid is limited in summer semesters, which limits access to summer classes for most students.
