Presentation:

The College awarded 591 degrees and certificates in 2018: 226 Associate degrees and 365 certificates. The Associate in Applied Science degree yielded the highest completion rate with 99 graduates in FY18 and was up from 87 in FY17. The Associate in Arts degree yielded 79 graduates in FY18 and was also up from 67 in FY17. The Associate in Science degree decreased from 82 graduates in FY17 to 36 graduates in FY18. The Associate in Liberal Studies degree increased to 8 completions in FY18 from 7 in FY2017. The Associate in Engineering Science remained level from FY2017 to FY2018 with 3 graduates. The Associate in Fine Arts also remained level with one graduate.

These numbers are expected to increase as the Director of Enrollment Services conducts an annual audit process that confers degrees to those who may have completed a degree or certificate.
