Presentation:

As of June 11, 2018, enrollment of Sauk's degree-seeking and certificate-seeking students had declined by 14.8% in headcount and 15.2% in credit hours in the 2018 summer semester as compared to the 2017 summer semester. Additionally, the number of credits that were paid for (not waived by the College) decreased by 8.4% over 2017. Federal Financial aid is limited in summer semesters, which limits access to summer classes for most students.

Business and Community Education enrollment has increased 465% over last summer due partly to large enrollments in the *College for Kids Black Rocket* programming. This programming focuses on science, gaming, and digital arts. CDL enrollment continues to be strong with 50 students having enrolled into the program since last July.
