Presentation:

The administration has been in the process of filling the Director of the Small Business Development Center. The position was advertised on-line on Sauk Valley Community College's website, in Sauk Valley Media (the *Dixon Telegraph* and the *Daily Gazette*), on-line on *Indeed.com*, and in the *Rockford Register Star*. Thirteen applications were received, and three candidates were interviewed. A committee was composed of Anita Carney, Joshua West, Dana Chacon, Bill Westcott (Mayor of Rock Falls), Kris Noble (Sauk Valley Chamber of Commerce), and Sally Scanlan (Community State Bank). Dr. Steve Nunez served as chair, and Dr. David Hellmich met with finalists.
