Presentation: FY 19 Enrollment Data

Fall:

The number of full-time equivalent (FTE) students declined by 6% from Fall 2017 to Fall 2018 (ICCB). Fall 2018 FTE enrollment was 1,028 (ICCB). The community colleges contiguous to Sauk saw Fall 2018 FTE enrollment decline by an average of 6.1%, while Sauk's peer group saw a decline of -3.4% (ICCB).

Spring:

Preliminary spring data show headcount is up from the previous spring by 3.5% while total credit hours are down by 2.1%. Paid enrollment has increased by 15.2% from the previous spring (Internal Sauk data from January 17, 2018). Items of interest for the spring term include the following:

- Dual Credit enrollment is down 9.0% in headcount and 11.9% in credit hours.
- Full-time enrollment is up 3.6% in headcount and 1.1% in credit hours.
- Non-traditional student (age 24+) enrollment is down 12.2% in headcount and 13.4% in number of credit hours while traditional student (under age 24) enrollment is up 7.5% in headcount and 5.7% in credit hours.
- Non-credit Business and Community Education headcount has increased 139.7% over Spring 2017 while for-credit headcount has increased 200%.
- Student-Athlete enrollment is up 20.3% in headcount and 8.0% in credit hours.
- Former WACC student enrollment is up 29.0% in headcount and 26.1% in credit hours.
- Sauk Scholar enrollment is down 17.2% in headcount and 20.6% in credit hours.
- Online enrollment is up 2.9% in headcount and 7.1% in credit hours.
