FY 20 Enrollment Data

Preliminary spring data show headcount is down from the previous spring by -8.2% while total credit hours are down by -2.4%. Paid enrollment has decreased by -0.5% from the previous spring (Internal Sauk data from January 16, 2020).

Items of interest for the spring term include the following:

- Dual Credit enrollment is down -8.8% in headcount and down -4.0% in number of credit hours:
- Full-time enrollment is down -2.3% in headcount and down -0.1% in number of credit hours;
- Part-time enrollment is down -7.1% in headcount and down -4.3% in number of credit hours;
- Transfer degree student enrollment is up 0.4% in headcount and up 1.9% in number of credit hours;
- CTE student enrollment is down -11.7% in headcount and down -15% in number of credit hours;
- Athlete enrollment is up 27.3% in headcount and 29.9% in number of credit hours;
- Former WACC student enrollment is down -5.0% in headcount and down -1.3% in number of credit hours;
- Sauk Scholar enrollment is up 4.3% in headcount and 5.7% in number of credit hours; and
- Online enrollment is down -3.8% in headcount and down -5.0% in number of credit hours.
