Presentation:

The administration has been in the process of filling two Nursing Faculty positions. The positions were advertised on-line on Sauk Valley Community College's website, in Sauk Valley Media (the *Dixon Telegraph* and the *Daily Gazette*), and on-line on *Indeed.com*. The College received eight applications, and two candidates have been interviewed. A committee was composed of Jane Verbout, Kimberly Cole, Therese Wood, and Megan Rivera. Christine Vincent, Dean of Health Professions, served as chair. Dr. Jon Mandrell and Dr. Hellmich met with each of the finalists.

Academic background: Pam Eubanks graduated from the University of Phoenix with her Master's degree in Nursing and OSF St. Francis Medical Center College of Nursing with a Bachelor's degree in Nursing. She also attended Sauk Valley Community College to obtain her pre-requisites for nursing.

Professional background: Pam is currently the Director of Nursing at KSB Hospital. She was the Manager of Operations and Clinical Nurse Manager at OSF St. Anthony Medical Center. She also worked at Rockford Memorial Hospital as a Clinical Resource Coordinator and Clinical Shift Coordinator.

Recommendation:

The administration recommends the Board approve the appointment of Pam Eubanks for the 2020-2021 academic year as an Assistant Professor of Nursing beginning August 14, 2020 at an annual base salary of \$52,476.
