#### **Presentation:**

The attached Memorandum of Understanding between the Sauk Valley Community College Adjunct Faculty Association, IEA-NEA and the Sauk Valley Community College District #506 Board of Trustees provides for a 3% salary increase for FY22, a 2% salary increase for FY23, and a 2% salary increase for FY24.

#### **Recommendation:**

The administration recommends the Board approve as presented the Memorandum of Understanding between the Sauk Valley Community College Adjunct Faculty Association, IEANEA and the Sauk Valley Community College District #506 Board of Trustees.

# Tentative Agreement between the Sauk Valley Community College Adjunct Faculty Association, IEA-NEA and the Sauk Valley Community College District #506 Board of Trustees

## Successor Agreement 2021-2024

The parties agree to extend the current collective bargaining agreement for a period of three (3) additional years. All language provisions of the contract will remain unchanged until a successor agreement is negotiated and ratified by the parties. The parties also agree to a three percent (3%) increase in compensation for the 2020-2021 academic year, a two percent (2%) increase in compensation for the 2022-2023 academic year and a two percent (2%) increase in compensation for the 2023-2024 academic year, reflected in the provisions of Article 7.1.1 and 7.1.2 of the collective bargaining agreement as follows:

7.1.1 Faculty who teach only non-transferable or developmental courses will have an appropriate Associate's or Bachelor's degree in the field and/or a combination of relevant education, training or tested experience. Compensation is determined for each of the three (30 academic years as follows:

2021-2022: \$828 per class load hour 2022-2023: \$845 per class load hour 2023-2024: \$862 per class load hour

7.1.2 Faculty who teach for-credit general education or transfer courses will have a Master's degree or Doctorate in the teaching discipline or related fields or a Master's degree or Doctorate in an unrelated discipline plus 18 graduate credit hours in the teaching discipline. Compensation is determined for each of the three (3) academic years as follows:

2021-2022: \$948 per class load hour 2022-2023: \$967 per class load hour 2023-2024: \$987 per class load hour

Once ratified by the Association and the Board, these terms will be incorporated into the collective bargaining agreement which will expire on July 31, 2024.
