Presentation:

Preliminary spring data show headcount is down from the previous spring by 21% while total credit hours are down by 16.9%. Paid enrollment has decreased by 14.9% from the previous spring. Items of note for the spring term include the following:

- Dual Credit enrollment is down 23.2% in headcount and down 22.5% in number of credit hours;
- Full-time enrollment is down 7.5% in headcount and down 9.2% in number of credit hours;
- Part-time enrollment is down 26.6% in headcount and down 29.6% in number of credit hours;
- Transfer degree student enrollment is down 9.7% in headcount and down 10.5% in number of credit hours;
- CTE student enrollment is down 21.5% in headcount and down 12.7% in number of credit hours;
- Athlete enrollment is up 4.5% in headcount and 1.2% in number of credit hours;
- Former WACC student enrollment is up 39.5% in headcount and up 28.5% in number of credit hours; and
- Sauk Scholar enrollment is up 14.9% in headcount and up 18.8% in number of credit hours.
