Presentation:

Summer data show headcount is up from the previous summer by 0.2% while total credit hours are down by 9.0%. Paid enrollment has decreased by 8.6% from the previous summer (Internal Sauk data from June 13, 2021). Items of interest for the summer term are the following:

- Non-traditional student (age 24+) enrollment is up 3.5% in headcount and is down 1.1% in number of credit hours while traditional student (under age 24) enrollment is down 7.2% in headcount and 11.4% in number of credit hours.
- Former WACC student enrollment is down 47.8% in headcount and 55.9% in number of credit hours.
- CTE enrollment is up 3.2% in headcount and 13.0% in credit hours while transfer degree enrollment is up 14.7% in headcount and 0.3% in credit hours.
- Undeclared transfer degree enrollment is down 35.1% in headcount and 45.7% in number of credit hours while course enrollee enrollment is down 30.9% in headcount and 30.0% in number of credit hours.
- Recent high school graduate enrollment is up 14.8% in headcount and down 4.9% in number of credit hours

These numbers reflect an increase in transfer and CTE enrollment and a sharp decline in undeclared transfer and course enrollee student enrollment, which can be largely explained by the continued effects of COVID-19. Last summer saw declines in transfer and CTE enrollment, while undeclared and course enrollee enrollment increased, likely from an influx of students from four-year universities wanting to take summer courses online. Childcare likely continues to be an issue for some non-traditional students. Additionally, transfer students may be sitting the summer term out after a year of virtual learning. Enrollment being down from summer 2019 is consistent with what other community colleges have been reporting across the state.
