Presentation:

The administration has been in the process of hiring a Criminal Justice Faculty position. The position was advertised on-line on Sauk Valley Community College's website, *Glassdoor.com*, *Higherjobs.com*, *Indeed.com*, and in Sauk Valley Media (the *Dixon Telegraph* and the *Daily Gazette*). The College received nineteen applications, and the committee interviewed four candidates. A committee was composed of Dr. Jon Mandrell, Dr. James Wright, Dr. Amy Jakobsen, and Kyle Kellen. Joshua West, Dean of Business, Career, and Technical Programs, served as chair.

Academic background: Stephen Miko is attending Northern Illinois University to earn his Ed.D. in Adult and Higher Education. He graduated from Western Illinois University with a Master's degree and Bachelor's degree in Law Enforcement and Justice Administration,

Professional background: Stephen is a Police Officer for the City of Glen Ellyn and has been in his position since 2001.

Recommendation:

The administration recommends the Board approve the appointment of Stephen Miko for the 2021-2022 academic year as an Associate Professor II of Criminal Justice beginning August 13, 2021 at an annual base salary of \$60,668.40.
