Sauk Valley Community College remembers Keith Bos, former Special Needs Coordinator. Keith served in the army for two years where he specialized in medic training and played army football, which earned him a football scholarship to Eastern New Mexico University. In 1962, he attended Northern Illinois University and graduated with a degree in Special Education. He graduated from the University of Illinois in 1968 with a master's degree in education. Keith worked as a special education teacher at Sterling High School from 1963 to 1975, at which time he was promoted to Assistant Vice Principal until his retirement in 1994.
