Presentation:

Sauk Summer Launch is designed to prepare students for college and kick start their SVCC journey. It will help students build the necessary skills, tools, and resources needed for college success.

Participants enrolled in the Sauk Summer Launch program may be eligible to receive a laptop if they successfully complete the program and meet other eligibility criteria. The College will need to purchase 35 laptops at \$1,041.43 each, totaling \$36,450.05 for the summer 2021 program enrollees.

The laptops will be purchased from CDW-G through IPHEC2011, a contract solicited and negotiated though the Illinois Public Higher Education Cooperative (IPHEC). IPHEC2011 conforms to Illinois Public Community College Act (110 ILCS 805) and SVCC Board Purchasing Policy (305.01) public notice/bid requirements.

The purchase will be funded through Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) federal stimulus funds.

Recommendation:

The administration recommends the Board approve the purchase of 35 laptops for the Sauk Launch summer program through contract IPHEC2011 with \$36,450.05 paid to CDW-G from federal HEERF funds.
