Each year, Sauk seeks to reaffirm its mission, vision, values, and strategic plan to ensure that they still reflect the needs of the community that Sauk serves and the direction of the Board of Trustees. Supporting documents also show Sauk's strategic plan. The strategic plan is presented in three distinct sections:

- Goal 1: Increase Access to Educational Opportunities
- Goal 2: Increase Academic Achievement
- College Health Metrics

Sauk's Organizational Planning and Improvement Committee (OPIC) has nearly completed the process of collecting data and feedback from internal and external stakeholders. The committee has begun drafting Sauk's new strategic plan with a first draft expected in early March.
