#### **Presentation:**

One of the College's strategic initiatives is the implementation of the Sauk Valley Community College Impact Program. SVCC's earned-tuition program provides eligible students who graduate within the Sauk district the opportunity to earn tuition and fees for up to three years at SVCC, or until they earn their certificate or degree, whichever comes first. The SVCC Impact Program will harness the collective power of Sauk Valley partners and communities to create an effective, supportive, sustainable path for students to pursue a college education and achieve career success through lifelong learning, public service, and economic advancement.

*Academic background:* Ashleigh Sorenson has a Master of Science in Education in Adult and Higher Education/Student Affairs and a Bachelor of Science in Psychology from Northern Illinois University.

*Professional background:* Ashleigh began employment with Sauk Valley Community College in January 2018 as an Academic Advisor. She was promoted to Academic Advisor for SHARP in March 2020 and became the Impact Program Coordinator in April 2022.

#### **Recommendation:**

The administration recommends the Board approve the appointment of Ashleigh Sorenson as the Impact Program Director beginning June 26, 2023, at an annual salary of \$69,867.20.
