## **Presentation:**

Fall enrollment shows headcount is up from the previous fall by 1.5% while total credit hours are up by 1.8%. Paid enrollment has increased by 2.5% from the previous fall (as of August 17, 2022; two days into the start of the semester). Items of interest for the fall term include the following:

- Part-time students (enrolled in <12 credit hours) are down 9.8% in headcount and 8.9% in number of credit hours while full-time (enrolled in 12+ credit hours) enrollment is up 6.6% in headcount and 6.6% in number of credit hours.
- Non-traditional student (age 24+) enrollment is down 5.8% in headcount and up 0.2% in number of credit hours while traditional student (under age 24) enrollment is up 0.8% in headcount and 2.2% in number of credit hours.
- First generation student enrollment (students whose parents do not hold a degree) is up 0.2% in headcount and 4.3% in number of credit hours, whereas TRIO students have seen larger declines of 31.6% in headcount and 32.8% in credit hours.
- CTE enrollment is up 3.8% in headcount and 3.4% in credit hours while transfer degree enrollment is up 0.2% in headcount and up 2.7% in credit hours.
- Course enrollees are down 20% in headcount but 5.4% in credit hours while undeclared transfer students are also seeing a decrease of 13.8% in headcount and 5.0% in credit hours.
- Recent high school graduate enrollment is up 10.2% in headcount and up 11.2% in number of credit hours. Dual-credit enrollment is up at 2.7% in headcount and up 2.4% in credit hours.
- The courses for fall 2022 with the largest increases in credit hours from fall 2021 are Physics with 77.1%; Earth Science, Geology, and Astronomy with 40.5%; Electronics with 39%; Early Childhood Education with 29.2%; and Industrial Machining with 26.3%.
