Topic: FY 2023 Spring Enrollment Update

Presentation:

Spring headcount is up from the previous spring semester by 0.3% while total credit hours are up by 3.2%. Paid enrollment (excluding Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment, Adult Education, and the Non-credit side of Business and Community Education) has increased by 7.4% from the previous spring semester (as of January 16, 2023; one day into the start of the semester). Items of interest for the spring term include the following:

- Male students have seen a major increase in enrollment this from 4,241.5 hours in spring 2022 to 4,828.5 in spring 2023 (+13.8% or 587 hours). The highest enrollments are in general education courses: English 152, Math 118, and Biology 85.
- Part-time student enrollment (enrolled in <12 credit hours) is down 9.8% in headcount and 5.5% in number of credit hours while full-time students (enrolled in 12+ credit hours) enrollment is up 10.7% in headcount and 9.8% in number of credit hours.
- There is a large increase post-COVID for daytime courses with a 10.2% (+676.5) increase in credit hours but a decrease of 5.4% (-194) credit hours for online.
- Non-traditional student (age 24+) enrollment is down 14.5% in headcount and down 7.5% in number of credit hours while traditional student (under age 24) enrollment is up 7.2% in headcount and 8.7% in number of credit hours.
- First generation student enrollment (students whose parents do not hold a degree) is up 1.9% in headcount and 7.4% in number of credit hours.
- CTE Enrollment is up 13.4% in headcount and 13.6% in credit hours while transfer degree enrollment is down overall with 1.6% in headcount and up 1.3% in credit hours, meaning that fewer students are enrolling in more hours on average.
- Course enrollees (students here to complete one or more courses) are down 50.6% in headcount and 46.4% in credit hours. Undeclared transfer students are seeing a decrease of 2.4% in headcount but are up 7.1% in credit hours.
- Recent high school graduate enrollment is up 20.0% in headcount and up 19.2% in number of credit hours. Dual-Credit/Dual enrollment is down 10.7% in headcount and down 5.5% in credit hours.
- The courses for spring 2023 with the largest increases in credit hours from spring 2022 are English with 18% (165 hours), Nursing with 14% (156 hours), Welding with 134% (146 hours), Math with 7% (77 hours), and Biology with a 5% (53 hours) increase.
