Presentation:

The College is experiencing rapid growth in health professions, particularly in CNA. Most notably, in Fall of 2023, Sterling High School has requested an increase in enrollment from sixteen to forty-one students, creating the need for an additional CNA full-time faculty member. The College's PATH grant continues to provide funding that emphasizes growth for healthcare programs.

Academic background: Katy Keller is continuing her education with Western Governor's University as she pursues a MSN. She graduated from Sauk Valley Community in 2014 with her ADN.

Professional background: Katy began employment with Sauk Valley Community College in July 2018 as a CNA Adjunct Instructor. She was a Certified Nursing Assistant and Registered Nurse in the Medical/Surgical Department at KSB from 2010 to 2018.

Recommendation:

The administration recommends the Board approve the non-tenure track appointment of Katy Keller as CNA Faculty beginning August 11, 2023, at an annual salary of \$47,106.67. The position is contingent on grant funding.
