Topic: Faculty Appointment – Mathematics

Mission: Sauk Valley Community College is dedicated to teaching and scholarship while engaging the community in lifelong learning, public service, and economic development.

Presentation:

The administration has been in the process of hiring a Mathematics Faculty. The position was advertised on-line on Sauk Valley Community College's website, *Indeed.com*, Chronicle of Higher Education, *HigherEdJobs.com*, and in Sauk Valley Media (the *Dixon Telegraph* and the *Daily Gazette*). The College received thirty-six applications, and four candidates were invited for an on-campus interview. A committee was composed of Brian Johnson, Wendy Rienstra, Brad Smith, and Carrie Conderman. Dr. Patrice Hess, Dean of Transfer Programs and Academic Support Services served as Chair.

Academic Background: Evan Hunziker received his Master of Education in Mathematics Education from American College of Education and a Master of Science in Curriculum and Instruction from Western Governors University.

Professional Background: Evan has been employed at SVCC since June 2024 as adjunct mathematics instructor. He was a mathematics teacher and Dean of Students for Aquin Catholic Schools for two years.

Recommendation:

The administration recommends the Board approve the appointment of Evan Hunziker as an Assistant Professor II of Mathematics beginning August 9, 2024 at an annual base salary of \$50,492.77.
