Attached are sample highlights of SVCC accomplishments during the current fiscal year and accomplishments to achieve during the upcoming fiscal year.

## Sample of Sauk Accomplishments for FY 2025

- Achieved 97% accessibility rates in online courses
- Achieved the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) pass rates of 95% and the Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) pass rates of 91%
- Began renovation to the second-floor north wing for Information Technology office, Sonography classroom, and faculty offices
- Celebrated 20 Illinois High School Diploma graduates, 18 Project VITAL participants, and 79 ESL and GED students who achieved reading-level gains
- Celebrated and honored the legacies of long-time veteran faculty and staff retiring in 2024-2025
