Professor Brevitt has been employed with Sauk Valley Community College since August 2003 as a Radiologic Technology Professor. She has worked in the field of Radiography for 25 years covering a variety of areas including pediatric, surgery, emergency department, fluoroscopy, and portable radiography.

*Comments from Nomination:* Dianna has been instrumental in providing high-level radiologic technology instruction since she was hired in 2003.
