




- Kids not always wearing their mask properly


4th Grade

- Computer issues

- Worse about turning in homework while at home
- Not doing any remote learning
- Some kids need to be in a classroom setting to learn
- Students may not have guidance on remote days.



- Students are behind

 Trying to include students at home and in school
- More stress
- Lesson plans are more difficult to plan







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


At the end of 2019 the United States was short 300,000



- The Economic Policy Institute reports that as of September, public K-12 education employment is more than half a million jobs below its year-ago levels.



- Parents may not understand the content and how to teach it








- Teaches us how to plan lessons

OUR FAVORITE EDUCATION PATHWAY EXPERIENCES


- I have been in a Junior English class, kindergarten, and 2nd grade.
