

# AMMUNITION

- The Sauk Valley Community College Police Academy is requiring agencies to supply 1200 rounds of handgun ammunition for each recruit attending the academy.

Any ammunition not used will be sent back with the students upon graduation.

- Handguns and ammo will be required at week 5 and should be brought to the Director's office on Orientation Day or the Sunday prior to week 5. After the handgun and ammo is turned in, recruits will not get it back until graduation.
- All handguns will be unloaded and in a case. Ammunition is to be kept separate.
- All semi-auto handguns shall have one magazine to be turned in with the handgun for inspection. A minimum of two additional magazines (empty and kept with recruit) for training purposes. For single stack pistols, it is recommended recruits have five magazines.
- Duty gear is supplied by the agency. A minimum of: belt, four belt keepers, holster, sufficient magazine pouches (speed loaders/cases for revolvers). A full duty belt is recommended.

1) Brass Case Only

5) Students can collect their own brass, using their own containers
