WHAT IS THE EARNED TUITION PROGRAM?

SVCC's EARNED TUITION program provides eligible students residing in the Sauk district the opportunity to EARN TUITION and fees for up to three years at SVCC, upon completion of high school.

WHY NOW?

Historic declines in population, college enrollment, college readiness, workforce development, median incomes, and housing prices paint a stark picture for the future of Illinois. Implementing pro-youth strategies is essential to reversing this backward momentum and propelling Illinois forward once again.









HOW CAN MY STUDENT QUALIFY?

- Register for the program by
 September 1, of the student's freshman year of high school
 - Graduate on time or early from a Sauk in-district high school
- Participate in 100 hours of community service before high school graduation (25 hours per year)
 - Apply for at least one local/state/national scholarship
 - Apply for FAFSA
