Illinois State University Requirements

**Students who major in Psychology must complete two laboratory courses. Biology courses are especially recommended. Additional required PSY research methods courses will be taken at ISU.

In order to be admitted to the Psychology major, transfer students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.50 and earn grades of C or better in: PSY 103, MAT115 or MAT 220 or MAT 221 or MAT 121 & MAT 122 or MAT 203; and one of the two laboratory science courses.

Math prerequisite is strongly encouraged before transfer if less than 30 hours earned.

The required PSY statistics course with SPSS labs will be taken at ISU.

No more than 16 hours of PSY courses from a community college will count toward the Psychology major.

AMALI/Non-western Graduation Requirement: All students graduating from ISU must have successfully completed an approved non-western course. SVCC approved courses: ART 118, GEO 122; PSC 233, 261; HIS 151, 152, 235, 245, 255, 265; PHL 104; SOC 115, 116.

BA Foreign Language Requirement: Students completing a BA must complete a third semester foreign language (Sauk LAN 261).

BS Graduation Requirement: Students pursuing a BS degree must have one additional science, math, statistics, and/or technology course (beyond the General Education requirements) which must meet certain criteria.
