TRANSFER FACTS

- The University of Wisconsin Platteville accepts the Associate in Arts or Science degrees from all Illinois Community Colleges. Transferring with these degrees will ensure students have met all university general education requirements.
- Students seeking admission must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0/4.0 in college transferable coursework and be in good standing at their college or university. Grades of "D" do transfer; however, some major courses may require a minimum grade of "C". Students begin a new GPA upon admission to UWP.
- Students completing the AA/AS degree will have the foreign language requirement waived.
 Students transferring without the AA/AS degree will be required to complete one semester of a single foreign language, unless they met the requirement by completing one year of high school foreign with a grade of "C" or better.
- Students are encouraged to apply early to ensure advance registration. For fall admission, students are encouraged to apply by January 1. For spring admission, students are encouraged to apply by September 1.
